Participants must be 4-H age 9-18, but preference will be given for members 4-H age 14-18 (for contests except intermediate meats). Preference is also awarded to those willing to do all contests. We will finalize our teams after our County Fair, but entries must be made to the state (by us) before our fair starts. We absolutely cannot add spots after August 1, but have to pay for all the spots we have registered for by August 1 (i.e. no refunds). T-shirt orders must also be paid for if you end up judging or not (unless a participant wants to buy the same size.)


