





Include challenges you faced and how you overcame them.

SECTION 2A: 4-H PROJECT LEARNING EXPERIENCES

Any format can be used.

Think of the blank page as a snapshot of your project.

How can you best show what you did/learned in your project with the fewest number of words?

An outline or bullet points work better than paragraphs of lengthy narrative sentences.

SECTION 2A: SUMMARIZATION OF 4-H PROJECT EXPERIENCES

Maximum 1 Page – Front Side Only; This page only – Do NOT add pages

Provide examples of learning experiences, (including, but not limited to, judging schools, camps, contests, tours) and things learned that provide evidence of growth in this project. Include challenges you have faced and how you overcame them. Where appropriate, indicate level of participation (L, C/D, A/R, S, N, I). Record keeping tools that may be helpful include: Kansas 4-H Permanent Record Section 2 and 3, project records, income expense records, etc. Use any format of your choosing, (narrative, bullets, charts, tables).

Example: Wildlife Project

Added bait fish to 3 farm ponds (30 lbs minnows, 100 bluegill). (L)

Learned that you must acclimate fish to water temperature before releasing them to prevent shock.

Learned that shocked fish will be stunned for long periods and it may even kill them.

Presented a PowerPoint on aeration in ponds for club meeting. (L)

Learned about the importance of oxygen in water.

Learned possible setups for aeration system in our ponds.

Attended a crappie fishing clinic at Tuttle Creek Park. (A/R)

Learned about specific times to catch crappie.

Learned about how to guess where crappie is most likely hiding

Completed a display on different fishing rods for county fair exhibit. (C)

Learned about individual parts of the rod.

Learned about different material possibilities for parts of the rod.




